







Practice Abstinence

The surest way to avoid STDs is to not have sex.



This means not having vaginal, oral, or anal sex.

Have Fewer Partners

Agree to only have sex with one person who agrees to only have sex with you.



Make sure you both get tested to know for sure that neither of you has an STD. This is one of the most reliable ways to avoid STDs.

Talk With Your Partner

Talk with your sex partner(s) about STDs and staying safe before having sex.

Why take a chance when we can know for sure?

Let's both get tested together!

It might be uncomfortable to start the conversation, but protecting your health is your responsibility.



Common Symptoms C

Odd odors, colors, textures, pain during intercourse or urination, odd discharges, blisters, warts, lesions, sores, rashes, flu-like symptoms or internal organ damage




Common treatments C

Antibiotics, antiviral medication, laser, or cryosurgery




Chlamydia — Rates of Reported Cases by Age and Sex, United States, 2019





Gonorrhea — Rates of Reported Cases by Age Group and Sex, United States, 2019




Primary and Secondary Syphilis — Rates of Reported Cases by Age Group and Sex, United States, 2019

Avoiding Dangerous Situations


- Don't ignore red flags
